Rebecca Pearce is a resident company member of Opera Idaho where she covered the role of Zerlina in Don Giovanni and enjoyed other roles such as; Ado Annie in Oklahoma, Nella in Gianni Schicchi, and Countess Ceprano in Rigoletto. She performed in numerous other Opera Idaho events including; Ales and Arias, Opera Idaho Goes to the Library, Bel Canto Concert, Golden Age of Operettas, Art Song Series, Operatinis, Mostly Mozart Concert, Auction of Arias, Black and White Gala, Broadway Bingo and several other events. She is also Currently a Member of Opera Elect, a new upcoming Company featuring living Composers. As well as, Resident Company member of Treasure Valley Opera Collective. She toured Rome and Orvieto, Italy, and covered the role of Susanna in the Marriage of Figaro for Operafestival Di Roma.

Rebecca placed in the nation's top 20 in both Musical Theater and Classical Emerging Pro Divisions in the National Classical Singer Vocal Competition 2019, top 40 in both categories in 2018, as well as top 40 in the National Classical Emerging Pro Division in 2016 and 2017. She was 4th in region at 2016 NATSAA 44th Annual NATS Artists Awards Competition for Singers. There, she was praised by judges for her "great stage presence and character," "beautiful voice, impressive range, and absolute control."

Locally, Rebecca Performs as lead singer with Trials and Tribulations Blues Band. She also organizes and performs across the Valley, Performed a sold out Patsy Cline tribute at the Sapphire room with Chad Spears and Gary Stafford. As well as, recently performed as Grace Farrell in Boise Little Theaters production of Annie. She also performed Muzzy in Boise Music Week's 2019 production of Thoroughly Modern Millie. She was the vocal Director at Dreamweaver Productions over Chitty, Chitty Bang, Bang, and Beauty and the Beast. She played Katherine in Shakespeare's Taming of the Shrew with Encore Theater. She was Guest Soloist for Something Special, Threads of Gold, and the LDS Women's Area Conference. She was guest soloist for Boise Hymns of Thanksgiving 2019 and 2017 at Century Link Arena and broadcast on PBS. Rebecca organizes and performs For the Love of Music concert series with pianists Chad Spears, Sean Rogers, Kelsey Webb, Betsi Hodges, Jeff Romero, and Lydia Brady including guest artists Sara Stejskal, Andrew Peck, Jason and Michelle Detwiler, and Curtis Crafton. As well as organized and performed A Night to Dream, Doris Day to Donizetti, and Patsy Cline to Puccini Concerts with Chad Spears and Kelsey Webb. Rebecca served as both MC and soloist at Impact Dance Alzheimer Benefit Concert and the 2018 Muscular Dystrophy Benefit Concert. She was guest soloist and conductor at the Boise Refugee Benefit Concert at Cathedral of the Rockies, guest artist at the Detwiler's Party of 4 concert, sang with St. Luke's Hospice Singers, guest soloist and conductor at Meridian's Community Collaborative Easter Program, Boise Festival of Trees soloist, and performed for several other private and corporate events including singing the National Anthem at several Boise Hawks' games. Rebecca also works on recording projects with violinist Kevin Lee at the Romantic School of Music in Southern Utah, and as a voice talent for radio commercials and film for local businesses including Mind Wind Films.

Rebecca has been soprano soloist in Handel's Messiah, Vivaldi's Gloria, and a Charles Gounod Concert. She soloed for Peter Covino's Orchestral Choir, performed with EVMCO Millennial Choirs in Phoenix, Arizona, Dr. Brady Allred's Salt Lake Choral Artists, and St. George Heritage Choir among others.

Rebecca was classically trained by the Utah Shakespearean Company, And grew up performing in musical theater such roles as; Narrator in Bad Guys of Broadway, Dora in Fiorello, Grandma Tzeitle and Fruma-Sarah in Fiddler on the Roof, Eliza Doolittle in My Fair Lady, Christine in Phantom of the Opera, Eponine and Cosette in Les Miserable, Nightingale of Samarkand and Princess number 12 in Once Upon a Mattress. She starred as Eliza Snow and Sarah Brown Young in Utah Historical Pageants. She also performs Bluegrass, Jazz, Cabaret, and American Songbook.
